How It Works

- All graduates from NHAA Accredited courses (including Naturopathy and Herbal Medicine courses) are eligible.
- One student of herbal medicine from each accredited course may receive the award.
- The award winner is nominated by the Herbal Medicine Faculty of the training institution, and approved by the Board of the National Herbalists Association of Australia.
- The award winner is presented with the award upon graduation, and publicised on the NHAA website.

The Prize

Award Winners receive the following:

- First year of NHAA Full Membership is free!
- Free entry to one NHAA Annual Seminar (or discounted entry to the NHAA International Conference if relevant).
- A copy of the Proceedings of a previous NHAA International Conference.
- NHAA Award Certificate.
